Analysis of feedback on curriculum

The college strictly follows its policy of collecting feedback (preferably online) with various stakeholders such as alumni, industry, employers, research agencies, parents, faculty members and students to identify areas of improvement in curriculum, infrastructure, support facilities, academic etc. The feedback from industry was also collected to test the employability skills of delivered curriculum and the strategies. Feedback was analyzed and compiled suggestions regarding curriculum were forwarded to Board of Studies of autonomous cell of our college. To our profound pleasure, feedbacks were given due consideration and implemented as far as possible. Based on the above feedback, college always ensures to provide certain 'Short Term Certificate Course' and 'Value Added Courses' to impart values and add skills to the existing knowledge of students. IIT Bombay Spoken Tutorial, IGNOU, courses from NSDC, SWAYAM NPTEL were some of them. Suggestions after feedback analysis were discussed in meeting of IQAC held and appropriate action was taken for institutional progress.

❖ **Feedback on Curriculum:**

1. **Students:** Majority of the students found the curriculum up-to-the mark in relevance to global educational needs. They found guest lectures, industrial visits and short-term certificate courses as an enriched learning tool supplementing the existing curriculum to enhance employability. They suggested to conduct more internships/ trainings/and hands-on exercises for better understanding of the practical oriented subjects.
2. **Alumni:** Alumni were of the opinion that although the curriculum is meeting global demands but need to be more employable and must be associated with direct placement strategies. According to alumni, co-curricular activities were par excellence and in complete relevance to continue un-interrupted learning and enhanced their personality and employability.
3. **Parents:** Parents were highly satisfied with the curriculum content and delivery. They appreciated co-curricular activities conducted and were of the opinion that those were unique for developing practical, vocational and employability skills.
4. **Faculty Members:** Faculty members considered the syllabus relevant with changing status of education but suggested inclusion of practical in accordance with the theory or some new emerging topics in the syllabi for better understanding and coordination with subject choices as per NEP-2020.
5. **Employers:** Employers elicited their contentment with the curriculum and the delivery. Students whom they employed had a good knowledge of subject. They just opined to expand practical skills in curriculum and improvement in communication skills including non-verbal for effective performance, while placement procedures.



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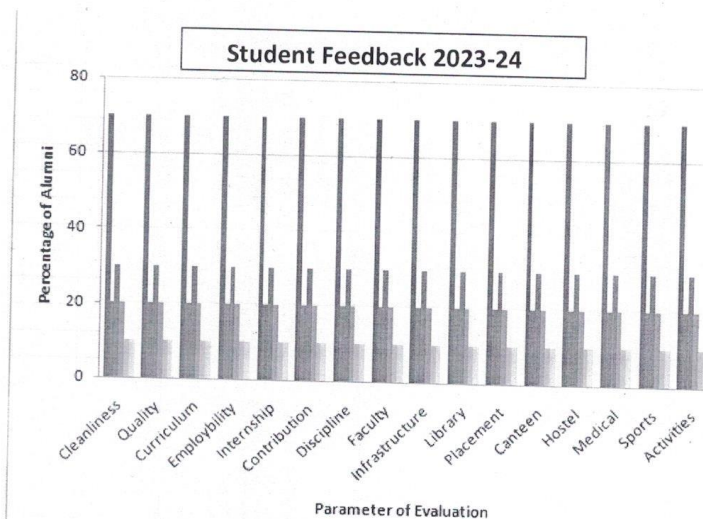
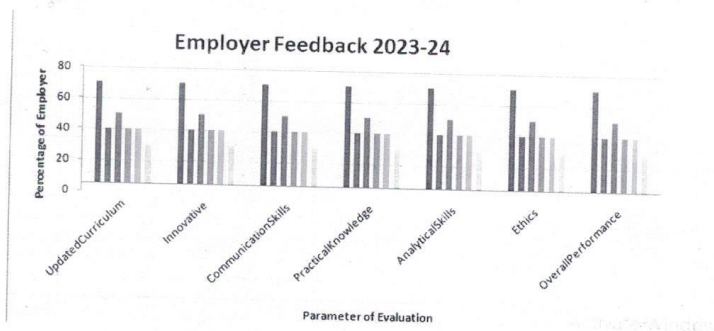
Action Taken Report of feedback Analysis

- ❖ Huge number of campus placement drives both offline and online were organized to provide employment to maximum number of students. A record number of students were selected with placement offers.


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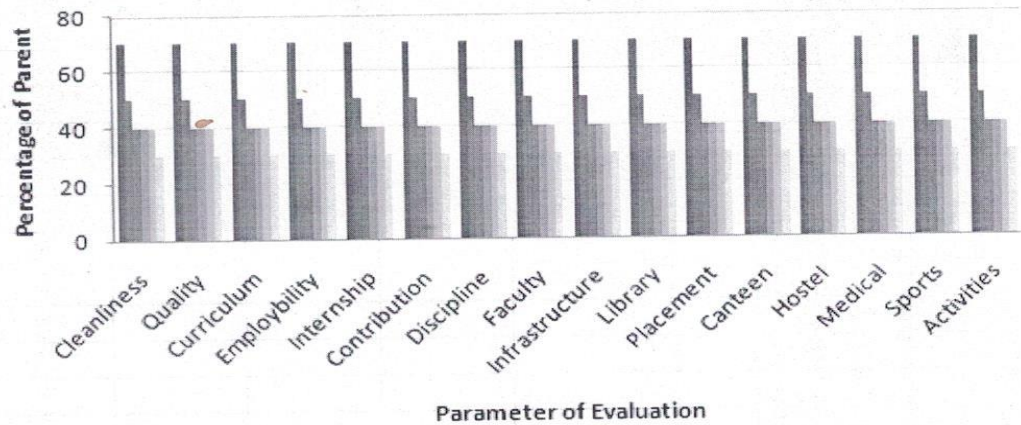
