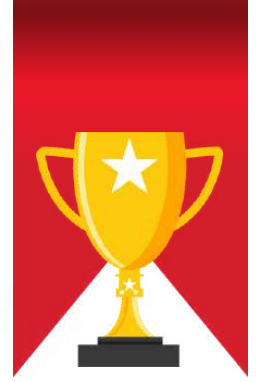
CAREER EXCELLENCE AWARDS 2023

- Indian Navy Adopts New Rank Insignia Inspired by Shivaji
Aligning with the PM's call to shed vestiges of colonialism, the Indian Navy has unveiled redesigned shoulder insignia for top Admirals incorporating elements from Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj's royal seal.

- **Bharatiya Space Station / Bharatiya Antariksha Station**

India aims to establish its own permanent space station called 'Bharatiya Space Station' over the next 25 years. The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) has set a target to launch the first module of this station by 2028.

- **Nina Singh Becomes First Woman Chief of Industrial Security Force**

Senior Indian Police Service officer Nina Singh took charge as Director General of the Central Industrial Security Force (CISF) recently. She became the first woman to head the specialized security organization and the 30th CISF Director General.

- **New Guidelines Address Concerns Over India's E-Commerce Tax Rule**

The CBDT has released detailed guidelines clarifying issues regarding Section 194-O of the Income Tax Act mandating a 1% Tax Deduction at Source (TDS) by e-commerce companies.

- **RBI Introduces Card-on-File Tokenisation Facility through Banks**

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has introduced a Card-on-File (CoF) tokenisation facility through banks, enabling cardholders to conveniently create and link tokens to their existing accounts with various e-commerce applications. The move allows CoF tokens to be generated directly through card-issuing banks and institutions, offering cardholders an additional choice for tokenising their cards across multiple merchant sites through a single process.



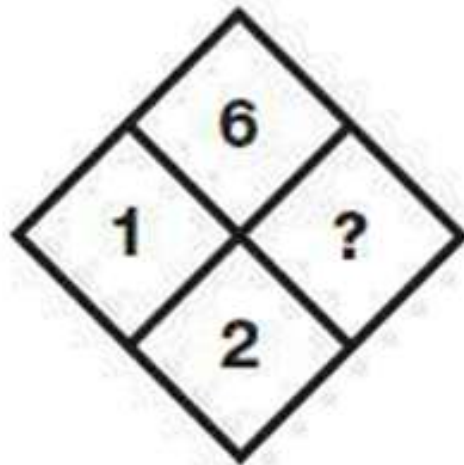
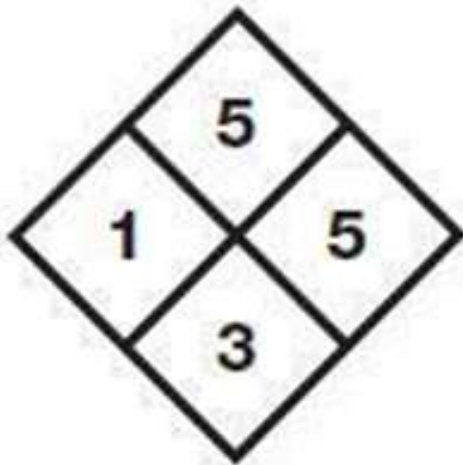
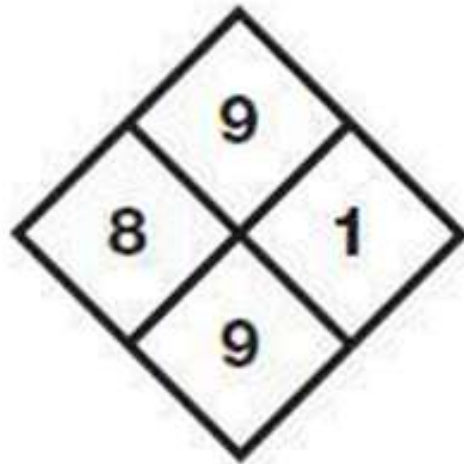
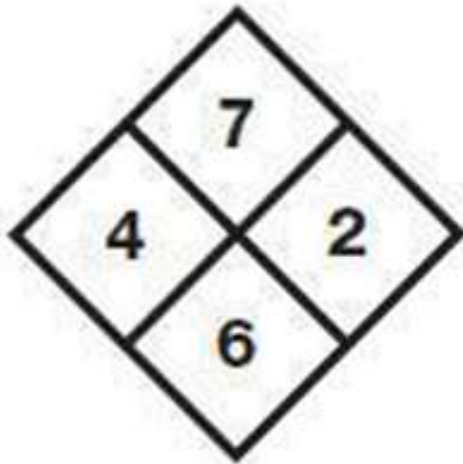

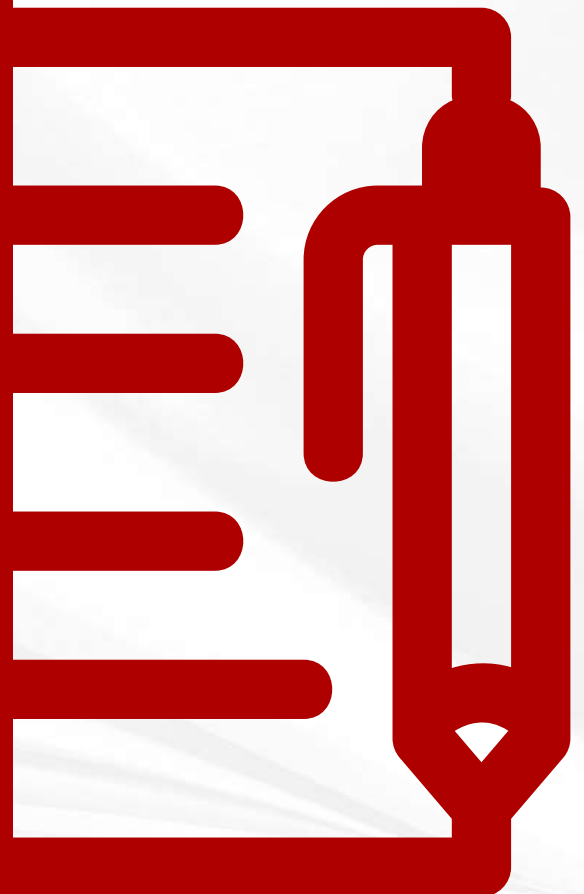
6- Explanation: Looking at the diagram in rows, the central circle equals half the sum of the numbers in the other circles to the left and right of the centre.
