





Mr Agnihotri explained the term microbial variability and how the multiplication of certain microorganisms in foods prior to consumption may result in production of toxins, e.g., *Clostridium botulinum*, *Staphylococcus aureus, and Bacillus cereus*. He also proposed that the integration of strain variability in prediction of microbial kinetics is, therefore, required in quantitative microbiology to obtain a more realistic prediction; and the most robust strains can be used in parallel or in cocktails to evaluate the efficacy of certain steps along the food production chain in controlling the growth. 
IDEATHON 1.0: Mind to Market-An initiative towards Atma Nirbhar Bharat


