Career College Policy for persons with Disabilities (PWD)

Disability is a term that includes motor and sensory limitations. It includes disabilities resulting from chronic illnesses and syndrome, blindness or low vision, mental illness, speech and language disabilities etc. To fulfill the educational rights of disabled students, the college has formulated a policy. The college believes that they are valuable human resources and should get equal opportunity. The college is against all kinds of discriminations on any grounds including disability.

The major initiatives to be taken as per the policy are:

- To ensure the design of the college building should include disable friendly facilities such as ramp/ lift etc.
- To ensure the availability of disabled friendly washrooms.
- To ensure the availability of wheel chair inside the campus.
- To provide a comprehensive and inclusive teaching and learning environment for disabled learners.

- To provide the facility of enquiry and information such as human assistance, reader, scribe soft copies of reading material etc.
- To provide placement support to the disabled students and assist them in getting employment after their studies.
- To provide counselling to the students with disabilities to select the best course at the higher education.
- To ensure the conducting of disability sensitization sessions and programs for creating awareness among students, teaching and non teaching staffs.
- To provide 25% scholarship to disabled students at the time of admission.






