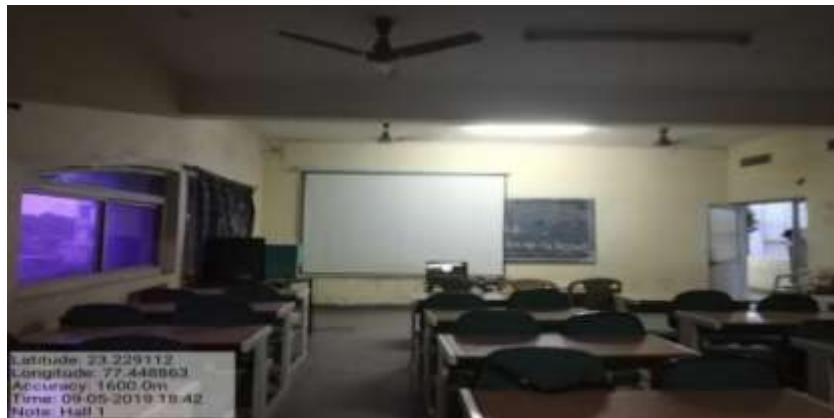





The need of the hour is to create awareness about HIV(Human Immunodeficiency Virus) and AIDS (Acquired Immunodeficiency Syndrome), raise money and also educate the masses about this disease, its symptoms, precautions to be taken and also about its prevention.



Self-Defense training (January 11-14, 2018):

Career College, Bhopal has formed a Women Empowerment Cell (WEC). This cell addresses and resolves all issues and complaints related to women. This cell has initiated a Self Defence Programme named as “NIRBHAYA” for girls to protect themselves and others from being a victim of circumstances. Main objective to organise this programme was to make girl students learn the mechanisms of self-defence so as to keep themselves safe and secure. Tactics included in this programme are exercises, kick, padding, jump, running, mock fight with boys, protecting themselves from strangers, protecting themselves when stranded in a lonely or desolate place, protecting them from assaulting agents knife, stick chains etc, protecting them from being gagged and tied by rope, duppata, saree etc. Students who took part in this training programme shared that they developed more confidence and also removed the fear of losing or getting controlled by others.



National Girl Child Day (24th January 2018):

Safe- Drive campaign for Girls in association with Rajpal Honda

WEC organized ‘Safe- Drive’ campaign for girls in association with Rajpal Honda on the occasion of ‘National Girl Child Day’. Team members of Rajpal Honda explained road safety measures through video and signs. They also organized an one day camp exclusively for girls on ‘How to drive safely’.





International Women's Day (8th March 2018):

On the occasion of 'International Women's Day' on 8th March 2018 WEC and Dept. of Biotechnology and Biochemistry organized a Guest Lecture by Dr. Indira Ghosh, Professor, School of Computational and Integrative Sciences, Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi. She spoke about the role of Women in Transforming India. She encourages and motivates the students and make them aware of opportunities she also encouraged the participants towards Entrepreneurship to generate self-employment and job creations. She also emphasized on the health status of Indian women.



Self Defense Program 'NIRBHAYA':

In India, the cases of gender violence are increasing and it is very important for women in India to learn self-defense for their own safety and survival. The aim of self defense program 'Nirbhaya' is to prepare girls for any situation that may harm to them. This year along with 'NIRBHAYA' WEC also organized a 7 days Self Defense Program from 21 March to 27 March 2018, in association with PakhiSamajikSewaSanstha, NGO, more than 120 girls was benefited by the camp.

Walkathon for a Cause (31st May 2018):

Walk for a Cause- *Jab Chalo Tab Savera*

In the early morning hours of 31st May 2018 thousands of Bhopalites including Career College and other college students, school children, homemakers, government officials, businessmen, social activists, and transgenders marched on the VIP Road of the city to express their concern for women safety. Walkathon of seven kilometers 'Walk for a Cause- Jab Chalo Tab Savera' was organized by the Madhya Pradesh Police Department to spread the message of zero tolerance towards crime against women. Women Empowerment Cell also participated in the Walkathon. Approx. 70 students of Career College participated in the event.



Awareness programme on health and hygiene of females (April 2, 2018):

Department of Commerce and Management organized an awareness programme on health and hygiene of females on April 2, 2018. This activity was aimed to create awareness regarding menstrual hygiene's importance and use of sanitary napkins, so that chronic diseases can be prevented in the rural areas. Usage of sanitary napkins's is virtually absent in rural areas. Poor menstrual hygiene can cause cervical cancer, infertility, fungal infections etc. To spread awareness on sanitation related issues 31 girl students participated accompanied by 8 female faculties. 82 sanitary napkins were distributed under this programme.

HUMAN VALUES

Code of Conduct for Student

All students are responsible for conducting themselves in a manner which helps enhance the environment of learning, dignity, freedom of each and every individual member in the college campus.

1. Students are expected to abide by the rules and regulations of the College and maintain the high standards of discipline and dignified manner of behavior inside as well as outside the College campus.
2. Students must fulfill the minimum 75% attendance criterion along with CCE and Project cum Presentation of the Semester and Annual System.
3. No student shall wander, or gather in verandah, corridor, and staircase or loiter anywhere in the college campus and abstain oneself from the classes.
4. All leave applications (Regular & Medical) shall be submitted in time, for sanction by HOD and concerned mentors.
5. Application for medical leave shall be accompanied by valid medical certificates.
6. Students shall come to the college in appropriate uniforms with formal white shirts tucked into Grey trousers with black belt for boys and white kurtas and Grey salwaar dupatta for girls with formal shoes. (Hawai type rubber or plastic chappals are not permitted)

7. Students are expected to maintain silence in the academic buildings, to maintain the decorum and not resort to any deviant behavior such as hooting, whistling, loitering etc. will be treated as an instance of indiscipline.
8. For independent study, students are encouraged to use the library, common computing facilities and not resort to sitting in staircases or circulation areas where they could interfere with the free movement.
9. Keep the campus neat and clean. Do not throw trash/waste anywhere in the campus except in the waste bins kept at different places in the college.
10. It is strictly prohibited to carry or consume intoxicants / psychotropic substances in any form or smoking or using chewing gum, tobacco, pan masala etc.
11. It is strongly advised to refrain from activities such as scribbling or noting on walls, door or furniture which could deface the college and destroy the academic ambiance.
12. No collections of cash or kind is allowed without prior permission of the Principal, HOD or Mentor.
13. College has to be 100% Ragging free.
14. Carefully handle the furniture, equipment, fixtures and appliances of the college and labs.

15. Political activity in any form is strictly forbidden in the College campus. Unauthorized meetings, propaganda work, processions or fund collections are forbidden within the College.
16. Any violation or non-compliance of existing rules or any observed behavior that deviates from the vision and mission of Career College will invite penalty in the form of warning, fine, calling of parents or any other disciplinary action can be taken by college authorities.

6. They should use ICT tools for teaching (audio/visual) to make the class and lecture more interesting and should ensure that their lectures are interactive.
7. Leave should be sanctioned from the Principal and ensure that alternative arrangements are made for the lecture and practical.
8. All the staff members need to carry their ID cards and follow the dress code of college.
9. Responsible and wise use of college property. Teachers should be alert and have a vigilant eye. In case of any misuse, damage of college property, they should report to the Principal.

14. 100 % fee exemption is given to the wards of faculties.
15. Medical benefits and medical concession are given to the faculty and staff members and their nearest relatives (kids and parents) in the society's hospital CIMS (50% discount in OPD, 25% in bed or room rent and 25% in Pathology).
16. ESIC and PF are given to eligible employees.

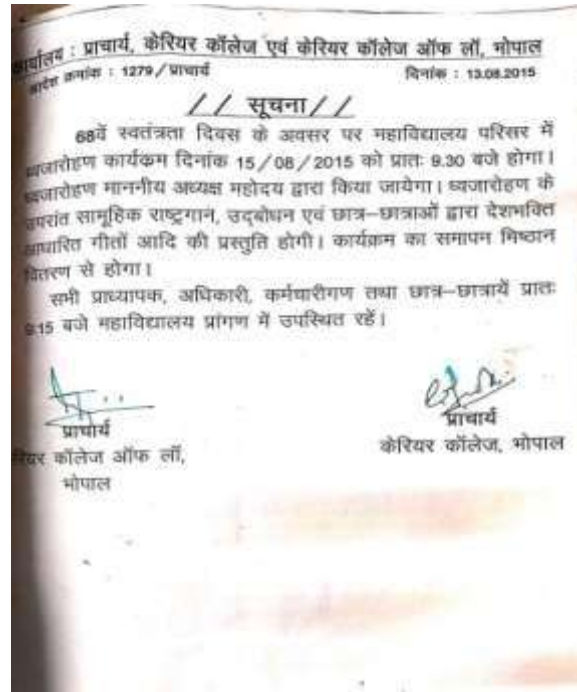

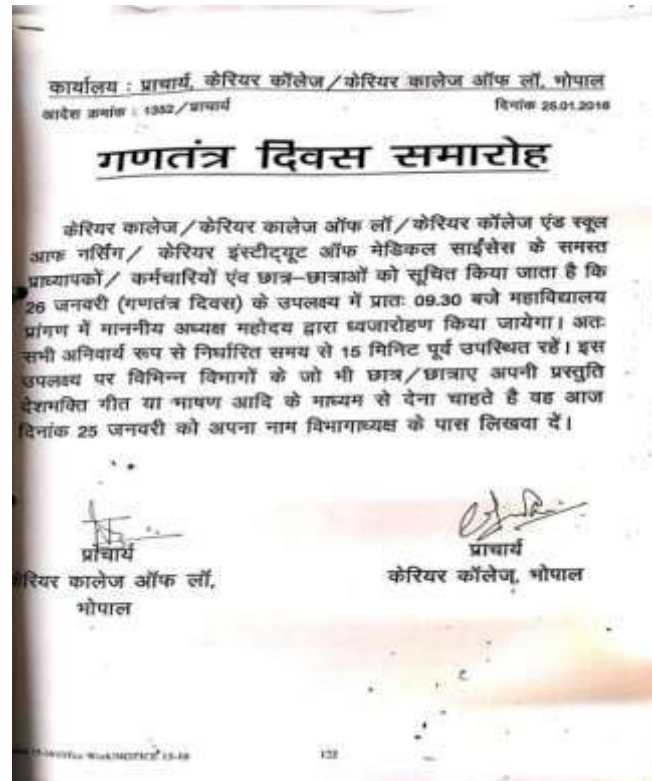
WEC organized a rally on the values of non – violence on the occasion of ‘Non- Violence Day’. Students interacted with the people to make them aware about the importance of non-violence.

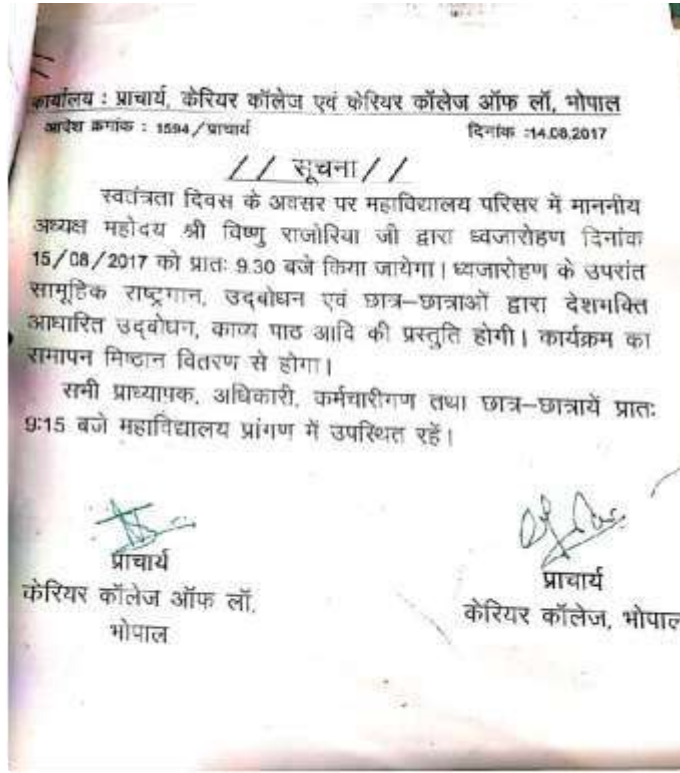

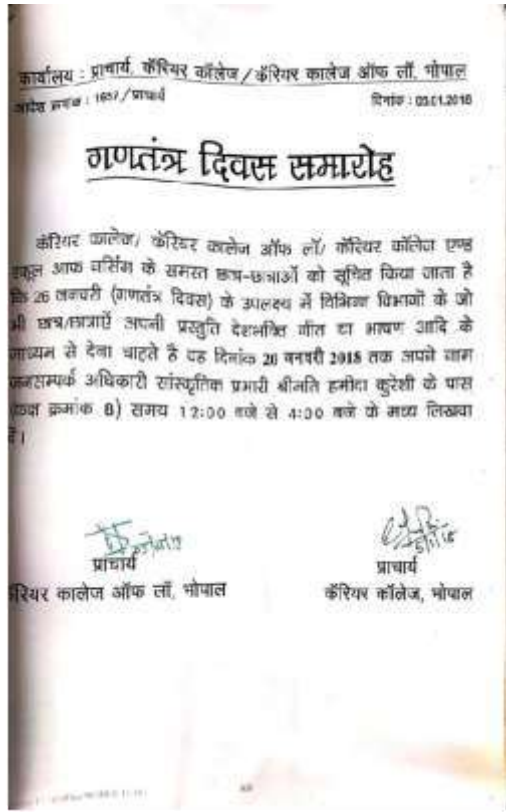
