


Code of Ethics for Research

We have a set of principles and guidelines that govern the conduct of research involving human subjects. These ethical principles aim to protect the rights, welfare, and dignity of individuals participating in research studies.

Ethics are:

- **Respect for autonomy:** Researchers must take consent before enrolling anyone in a study (If human/animal are involved).
- **Beneficence:** Researchers must strive to maximize the benefits and minimize the risks of research to society.
- **Plagiarism:** Researchers must avoid plagiarism and use the licensed anti-plagiarism software before submitting any manuscript.
- Providing training for researchers on research ethics. Monitoring research studies.
- **Confidentiality and Privacy:** Researchers must implement robust data security measures and adhere to privacy regulations to ensure the individuality of research.
- **Responsible Reporting:** Researchers have a responsibility to report their findings accurately and responsibly. They should avoid sensationalism or overinterpretation of results and acknowledge the limitations of their research.

By adhering to these ethical principles, researchers safeguard the well-being of participants, uphold the integrity of research, and maintain public trust in the research process.
